All trails in this area are Intermediate. They can be enjoyed by beginners and experts alike. Speed raises level of difficulty, but there is not much, except the Entrail that is not ride-able by less experienced riders.

The best trailhead is Keystone Canyon off of North Virginia Street @ Keystone Ave. There is lots of paved parking and a port-o-potty. The Softball Fields have gates that get closed and The Evan's Creek and Radio Towers access points are dirt.

There is no water and no services on the mountain at all. Distances are relative as it's all up, then all down. Evan's to the Bacon Strip

via the Bong Trail is a 2+ hour loop for fit riders, or a real epic for beginners. The shortest and easiest loop is The Evan's Creek to Minor's Trail, or Keystone to The Radio Towers. The longest loop is probably Evan's to The Bongtrail and down via Keystone, though the linkup back to Evan's is discontinuous.

It's a 20 to 30 minute ride from Downtown Reno to the Evan's Creek Trail via Ranscho San Rafael Park at the very end of Washington Street...
